National EMS Memorial Service Elects New Board Members

Colorado Springs, CO - The National EMS Memorial Service is pleased to announce the election, at its 2010 General Meeting, of Robert A. Hamilton, III and Jason M. Jenkins to its Board of Directors.

Rob Hamilton is a vice president for Air Methods Corp's Hospital Based Service Division in Englewood, Colorado.

Hamilton began his EMS career as a firefighter/paramedic in 1990 in York County, Virginia. After a tour on active duty with the United States Marine Corps, he return to EMS as a paramedic/flight medic with various agencies in Virginia and North Carolina.
